#### **INTENT TO APPLY FOR**

#### **2010 RECREATIONAL TRAILS PROGRAM GRANT**

As part of the grant requirements for the 2010 Recreational Trails Program “RTP”, which is offered through the South Carolina Department of Parks, Recreation, and Tourism, the City of Cayce will hold a public input session scheduled for Thursday, February 25, 2010 at 5:30 PM at the City Hall Complex, Council Chambers, located at 1800 12<sup>th</sup> Street Extension.

As part of the City’s overall desire to create a park system of trails and support services, we propose additional trails (Riverwalk Expansion – Trails – Phase III) to link from the existing Riverwalk Park (which is part of the overall Three Rivers Greenway Project) through designated right-of-way and run along the riverfront stretching from south of the City Water Plant then eventually ending at the Thomas Newman Boat Landing. This extension of trails, approximately ½ mile, would be constructed to meet the same standards as the existing Riverwalk Park.

The general public and other interested parties are encouraged to attend this public input session. Questions regarding the City’s intent to apply for this grant and/or review of documents relating to the grant are available for public inspection in the office of the Grants Coordinator, The City of Cayce.
